Awards

Each dog passing Fast CAT will be offered a light blue qualifying ribbon. Pick your Q ribbon up at the end of your run. Dog must cross the finish line. Dogs earning titles will be offered Rosettes. Get your title ribbon from the check-in table.

Tests offered and Other Important Information

NO BITCHES IN SEASON MAY RUN. ALL DOGS CAN RUN ON LIMITED SLIP, FLAT COLLAR, MARTINGALE, HARNESS OR NAKED. NO CHOKE, PINCH COLLARS ALLOWED. TAGS SHOULD BE REMOVED OR TAPED FLAT TO COLLARS. ALL DOGS MUST BE INSPECTED BEFORE EACH RUN.

A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any loose dog not competing while the test is in progress. Please pay at the check-in table.

Fast CAT: Open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and spayed/neutered dogs are eligible to participate. A dog may enter only once per event—defined by an event number. Canine Partner registration forms are available at the check-in table.

The Test Field Committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs. The Test Field Committee reserves the right to alter the track as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the test.

AKC Section 3.2: Bitches in season, or bitches which come in season after the close of entries, shall be barred from participating in the test and their entry fees refunded. Notification to the Field Secretary of bitches in season must be made before or during the roll call. Bitches known to be in season shall not be brought onto the test grounds.

No entry fee will be refunded if the test cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, loss of site, extreme weather conditions, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Test Field Committee.

Two separate tests are being offered each day and will run **concurrently**. You may use one entry form per dog to enter one or all tests by circling the information on the entry form. Each test requires a \$22 entry fee for pre-entered dogs. Late entries and day of entries are \$30. Conditional entries will not be accepted.

Entry forms may be mailed with check or emailed and paid through PayPal. Checks should be payable to Lost Coast Kennel Club. PayPal entries will include a 4.0% convenience fee.

You must provide two sturdy leashes (no show or retractable leads) for your dog; one to hold your dog and one to catch your dog. Please arrange for someone to either release or catch your dog, since you cannot be in two different places 100 yards apart. There will be dog holders/releasers, known as slippers, at the staging area. Be sure your dog can be caught at the end of the course. Exhibitors should be familiar with all AKC Fast CAT rules prior to running. The Event Chairperson will have a complete copy of the rules available at the test site. **Toys and treats may be in the catch area, out of sight, until after the dog crosses the line.**

Practice/FEO runs must be scheduled by 12 pm on each Test day and will be run after the end of each day's tests or when there is a lag in entries. The cost per run is \$10.00. Sign up at the check-in table. There will also be FEO runs on Thursday, July 18th between 1-3pm. Limit two runs per dog.

Test Hours: 8:00 am until completion. Scores will be posted on Telegram shortly after your run. Instructions regarding Telegram will be sent with your test confirmation. A printed copy of results is available the next day at the score table. Please check it for accuracy and inform Beth of needed corrections.

Inspection and check-in will begin each day at 8:00 am. The two tests will be run concurrently. Coursing for the first test will start as soon as dogs are checked in after the white dog has run. All dogs should check in by 2pm. Day of entries will close at 12pm each day. **All dogs will be inspected prior to their run as required by AKC.**

We are offering the flexibility for you to choose when to run your dog. Concurrent means you can run both runs in the morning, both in the afternoon. or one in the AM and one in the PM. We hope this reduces your stress level because we want you to have **FUN!!!!** Invite your friends. We have our lure coursing equipment, and we want to use it!

Directions.

Take CA 101 to Ferndale/Fernbridge Exit. If driving North, it's Exit 691. If driving South, it's Exit 692. Take HWY 211 across the Eel River over historic Fernbridge and continue to the Victorian Village of Ferndale. Turn right on Van Ness Ave, then left into the Fairgrounds through the D Gate. Follow the signs to the parking area.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
