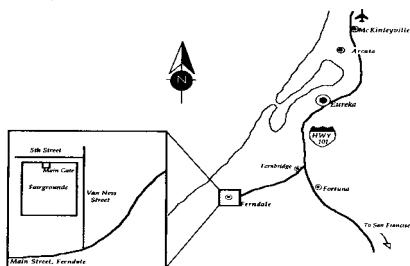
An Automated External Defibrillator (AED) is on the grounds of these events. The AED is located at the First Aid Booth.

DIRECTIONS TO THE EVENT SITE

From Hwy. 101 South exit 692; from Hwy. 101 North exit 691 - Take Ferndale/Fernbridge Exit; at Fernbridge turn South over the bridge; go approximately five miles and turn right on Van Ness Ave.; left on Fifth Street to Main Gate of Fairgrounds. Watch for direction signs.

TRAVELING NOTES:

Improvements to Hwy. 101 have made getting to Ferndale an easy scenic drive from San Francisco and Southern Oregon. The Fairgrounds are five miles from the ocean. Summer weather usually ranges from cool to moderately warm. Enjoy our cool coastal weather, stay and rest after the events or drive scenic Hwy. 101 north up the coast to the Coos Kennel Club four All-Breed Dog Shows at Coquille, OR. Hwy. 199 in Oregon may be subject to closures.



Best Veteran in Show Competition- Saturday

There will be a class offered for Veteran Dogs and a class for Veteran Bitches who are 7 years or over in all breeds/varieties with a selection of Best Veteran in each breed/variety following the judging of Best of Breed for that Breed/Variety. Spayed or neutered veterans are eligible to compete. Veterans **ARE NOT** eligible for Best of Breed/Variety Competition. All Best Veteran Breed/Variety winners will then compete in their respective groups for First through Fourth Placement. The first place winners of the Veteran Group Competition will then compete for Best Veteran in Show. **(See Page 9 for additional information).**

Veteran Groups will be judged after all Veteran breeds are finished judging.

Best Veteran in Show will be judged immediately after Saturday Best in Show.

The following breeds must be judged on a Ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Lagotto Romagnolo, Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden, Spanish Water Dogs. Breeds designated as ramp optional may, at the discretion of the judge, be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition. AKC Sanctioned 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Competition - Saturday & Sunday

Entry Fee: \$15.00 per puppy

This is a recorded event by the AKC for the Certificate of Merit and Puppy of Achievement certificates.

Section 1 - Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over, but under six months on the first day of the event. Classes will be offered for breed and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

Professional handlers or agents are only permitted to exhibit in FSS Open Shows if they are listed as an owner of record of the dog being exhibited. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.*

Dogs should be physically sound. No dog shall be judged if it is taped, bandaged, glued or has stitches anywhere including ears or tail in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the event grounds.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
