Awards: Flat ribbons will be awarded 1st—4th place in each jump height class to dogs with qualifying scores. Green ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying score. Dogs earning the MACH or PACH title will receive a special Rosette and pole. Anyone earning the AGCH Title will receive a special Rosette and pole. Master level dogs earning a Double, Triple, Quadruple, Quintuple or Sextuple Q will receive a corresponding pin – while supply lasts.

Judging Begins: 8:00 am each day.
Thursday: B Match will begin after Thursday Trial classes have completed.

Trial Hours: 7:30 am thru one half hour after completion of judging

Class Information and Obstacles

Classes offered: Regular Titling: Novice A & B, Open, Master/Excellent for Standard, JWW, FAST and T2B. Preferred: Novice, Open, Master/Excellent for Standard, JWW, FAST and T2B. Regular and Preferred Premier Standard and JWW. Owners are responsible for entering the proper class. Complete rules can be found on the AKC website at www.akc.org. For a copy of the rule book write to: American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Dr., Ste 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390. To place a credit card order by telephone call: 919-233-9767 voice and 919-816-3627 fax. Minimum order is \$10. Obstacles will conform to the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. FEO offered in all classes

Move-Up Regulations: Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. Day-to-day move-ups are allowed providing the Trial Secretary is notified at the show site, in writing, within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course.

Course Walk Through / Warm Up Area: Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in the class. A warmup jump will be provided for each ring.

Classes offered: Standard and JWW. One course will be set in each ring. You may run the numbered course or your own pattern. No scoring or prizes will be offered. Walk through will begin as soon as the course is set, approximately 12:00 pm. Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the match, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Dogs must be a minimum of 1 year in age. Any AKC eligible dog may enter. Dogs do not need to be entered in the regular trials. Dogs may be entered multiple times in the same class with a maximum of 4 runs per dog. Event is limited to 400 runs. Each run will be a maximum of 60 seconds.

Toys and clickers are allowed in the ring. Food is not allowed in the ring. Maximum course time will be strictly enforced. No harsh verbal or physical corrections allowed. Excusal for dog fouling the ring.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The Agility Trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners dogs provided their listing number has been recorded on entry form
- Agility Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of reason, there will be NO refund of entry fee.
- All refunds will be sent, by check, seven days after the event.
- After closing Bitches in Season will receive refund of amount paid less \$10 per day processing. Secretary must be notified by writing 30 minutes before the event begins
- Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by Action of the Trial Committee
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, weather, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the Organizing Committee
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry form. Illegible or incomplete entries cannot be accepted or entered in the event.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. This includes Entry Fees and RV Fees
- All dogs must always be on leash except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- Dogs under four months of age are prohibited at AKC Events
- Do not leave animals unattended in vehicles. The Club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of overheated animals.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California

Wait List: Lost Coast KC is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the closing date/time. A maximum of 100 runs will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary by 11:59 pm on July 8, 2026. Any entries withdrawn by 6:00 pm on July 14, 2026 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry a refund will be issued and mailed 7 days after the event. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm on July 16, 2026 will receive a refund.

Food and Beverages: Lunch will be provided for Judge, Show Committee and designated full time workers. Food and beverage will be available for purchase onsite.

Volunteers: Lost Coast KC would like to thank you in advance for volunteering to work at this event. Those volunteering in and around the rings during the event will receive a voucher valid towards \$2 at future Lost Coast Kennel Club agility trials and tickets for the Volunteer Drawing.

The rings will be outdoors on grass and measure 110' L x 100' W. Bring shade.

Directions

For those traveling North on 101 take the Ferndale exit 691. Go under the 101 following the road to the two way STOP signs at Fernbridge. Turn left. Be aware cars exiting the bridge have the right of way. Go across Fernbridge following Highway 211 toward Ferndale for approximately 5 miles. Turn right on Van Ness directly across from Ferndale Veterinary. Turn left on 5th Street. Turn left into the Fairgrounds and across the parking lot. Proceed through the entry gate . Turn right just past the restroom. There will be signs. .

For those traveling South on 101 take the Ferndale exit 692. At the end of the off ramp turn right. At the two way STOP signs at Fernbridge turn right. Go across Fernbridge following Highway 211 toward Ferndale for approximately 5 miles. Turn right on Van Ness directly across from Ferndale Veterinary. Turn left on 5th Street. Turn left into the Fairgrounds and across the parking lot. Proceed through the entry gate . Turn right just past the restroom. There will be signs.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
