

MINUTES OF THE LOST COAST KENNEL CLUB
January 21, 2020, The Adorni Center, Eureka

BOARD MEETING: Called to order by President Jill Otto at 6:35 pm.

Present: Sara Borok, Bill Clawson, Patty Mendes, Tina Moulton, Jill Otto, Kris Smith, Deb St Myers, Deb Tull, Cathy Wright.

Minutes of the Last Meeting: MSAC to approve as published.

Report of the Treasurer: Bill reported on our assets and distributed the Profit and Loss report. We show a 300% net increase in comparing 2018 and 2019, due to the successful Scent Work trials. Discussion of which judges need 1099s. Bill thanked Patty for her help with taking over the Treasurer position.

Unfinished Business:

- Ferndale HS soccer field improvement: Nothing new.
- City of Eureka Animal Ordinance: Nothing new.
- New state law AB5, which redefines independent contractors. There is such confusion about how to interpret this law as it applies to judges that the AKC is looking into it for California clubs.
- CCC donation: We can donate to the local group. We should donate right after a show or trial at which we use them so those kids get the benefit. Will recommend that the membership donate \$500 to the Fortuna CCC.
- FCAT timers: The Board will recommend to the membership that we reactivate the motion to buy timers for FastCat, which are now available.

New Business:

- Raffle Report to the State: We forgot to report after our raffle in 2019, so we have more reports and forms to fill out. Discussion of raffle income 2016, 2017, and 2018. Bill was encouraged to keep track of his expenses for materials for reimbursement.

The Board meeting was adjourned at 7:05 pm.

REGULAR MEETING: Called to order by President Jill Otto at 7:05 pm.

Present: All of the above plus Beverly Morgan Lewis.

Minutes of the Last Meeting: MSAC to approve as published.

Report of the President: Jill said the holiday party was small but fun, and thanked Chris Irvin for hosting.

Report of the Secretary: Mail – Thank-Yous from the Eureka Police, Friends for Life, Hospice of Humboldt, Guide Dogs for the Blind (both main office and local group), AKC Reunite, Canine Health Fund. A member returned an entry refund check as a donation. Will encourage Linda B to make sure the various agencies are receiving their WDJ subscriptions.

Report of the Treasurer: Bill reported on our assets. Dues are DUE. Discussion of who should receive notifications of checks received (event chairs, trophy sponsor chair, etc.)

Report of Committees:

- **Practice:** Tentative dates picked: Feb 23, Mar 8, Apr 5 & 26, May 10 & 17, all Sundays in June. Kris will check with the fairgrounds.
- **Newsletter:** Tina was congratulated on a good issue.
- **Website:** Working on updating dates. Renewal due for hosting – will pay for 3 years and domains.
- **Chat Group:** New io.groups for members – Tina said many members have joined, and she described different ways we can take advantage of what it offers.
- **Membership** – New list will come out after 2020 dues have been received.
- **Event Team:** Cathy said there was a small meeting. Premium list needs to be finalized. She passed around the trophy sponsor list and letters to take to possible donors. Next ET meeting, Feb 16 at the Mall at 2:30. The Biewer Terrier Club would like to put on two open shows on the same days as our open shows, so there would be four total.
- **Scent Work Trials:** Deb S.M. - May 30/31, Ferndale Fairgrounds. Four judges, about 300 searches per day, 2 trials each day. Detective will be separate, no novice. Set up on Friday in the Art building, Friendship Square, jockey quarters, and flower building. Considering a Novice trial in September. We will need lots of volunteers. Sniff ‘N Go practice at Ridgewood school in January – 12 dogs practiced, brought in \$100. Gave \$200 to the school. We are thankful they let us hold practices there..

- B-Ob Shows/Rally/FCAT: It's the 20th anniversary of the shows! Discussion of how large the new banner should be for the Ferndale intersection – not too big due to wind. Saturday BBQ – club sponsored and organized – tri-tip and oysters. Carriage – 2 ponies and a larger cart; they need more money for gas. **MSAC to offer the carriage people up to \$750 for all expenses.** The Biewer Terrier Club will do a Judges Education for Biewer Terriers. There will be two LCKC Open shows, on Fri & Sat, and the Biewer Terrier Club will host 2 additional Open shows, on those days. Their premium list will go at the back of ours. Deb T has updated the Summer Seaside Series flier. We will need someone to do the show poster. Discussion of where the old show photo books are which were provided by the photographers before they went on the thumb drive (anyone who has one of these, please let us know). **NEEDED: JUDGES LIAISON, PUBLICITY, HOSPITALITY.** Will offer Best Veteran on Saturday. Jill said we **HAVE TO** get going on judges for 2021. Please contact her or Cathy if you are willing to help, or have suggestions for judges. All is OK for Rally. Fast CAT: The timers are available now, so the following motion made in September 2019 was reactivated: **Motion made (Cathy) and seconded (Sara) to buy timing equipment for FastCAT, up to \$1700. The motion was voted on and passed.**
- Agility Trial/Barn Hunt/FCAT: Beverly said the new contract with Humboldt County Fair is increased for the soccer field by \$25 per day. The Barn Hunt contract is in negotiation with Redwood Ratters. Will be offered Fri, Sat, Sun.

Election of New Members: no applications

Unfinished Business:

- Whole Dog Journal subscriptions – Linda B will check to make sure they are being received.
- HumDOG Dog Expo – Sunday, March 1, set up on Saturday. LCKC supports this effort with member booths and the Parade of Breeds. Please sign up! Talk to Susan Hutchison. If you don't have a booth, please come to help. **MSAC (Sara/Cathy) to donate (2) \$50 gift cards for the spay/neuter raffle.**
- Tracking – An inquiry was received regarding if we have interested members and would be willing to put on trials. Not at this time.

New Business:

- The Board recommended that we donate to the local CCC. **MSAC (Cathy/Deb T) to donate \$500 to the local (Ferndale) CCC in appreciation for the young people who have come to help at our events.**
- Cathy said we are out of the LCKC pens that we use as gifts and for promotion. She suggested replacing them with a multi-functional pen, about \$.99 a piece. **MSAC (Patty/Sara) to order 200 promotional pens.**
