Report of the President: Skipped due to time restraints.

Report of the Secretary: Mail: Agility materials from Emily, FTB report, bank statements.

Report of the Treasurer: Bill summarized the attached Treasurer's Report.

## Report of Committees:

- Practice: The June 12 practice had a good turnout for all activities. Four or five showed up for conformation, Sara set up an advanced rally course, FCAT had a big turnout; lots of people are getting interested. Marilyn set out lots of things for 6-7 people for Scent Work. Emily said agility practices are well attended. A judge sent her some course designs, she wrote him a Thank You note, and got a nice reply in return. Next practice June 27.
- Event Team: Cathy sent out a poll on the i.o. group asking about interest in the scent work seminar and people's preferences and willingness to help. There were 4 people willing to take leadership roles, and a good response from people wanting the seminar. If we are going ahead in the fall, we need to apply to the AKC. We need a planning committee to set a site and date. There will be an Event Team meeting after practice on June 27 to determine the specifics.

- B-Ob Shows/Rally/FCAT 2022: Show: Some progress on judging assignments. Obedience/rally: Sara said there is nothing new at this time. FCAT: Deb T said nothing new. There is a new coffee wagon – Shots Coffee. Might be good for the shows, maybe for the upcoming agility trial.
- Agility Trial/Barn Hunt/FCAT 2021: Agility: Beverly needs to contact the county to see what COVID guidelines we still need to follow. Everything else is in place. Will send out a request for the basic preliminary set up crew on Wednesday, then will need everybody for Thursday morning set up and Monday take down. Deb SM is doing the volunteer drawing with donated items. Barn Hunt: Susan said everything is going smoothly, she will remind Nilson Feed about the straw bales and will send out a request for volunteers. FCAT: Deb T said it's getting harder for Terry Burchett to come up here for lure operating, so he will teach interested people how to use the equipment at a workshop on Thursday afternoon.
