# MINUTES OF THE LOST COAST KENNEL CLUB

September 21, 2021, via Internet

## BOARD MEETING

The Board meeting was called to order by President Jill Otto at 6:31 p.m.

Minutes of the Last Meeting: The minutes from the August 17, 2021 Board meeting were approved as published.

Report of the Treasurer: Bill gave a summary of the attached Treasurer's report. He said we have received donations in the amount of \$1100 toward the purchase of lure coursing equipment for FastCAT and need to officially accept them. **MSAC (Bill/Deb T) to accept the \$1100 in donations for FastCAT equipment.** Bill explained that the reason HumDOG rented our agility equipment rather than making a donation to LCKC is that, as a 501.c3 charitable non profit, they can't make donations except to other 501c3s and we are a 501c4. A suggestion was made that we not charge them anything, because we borrow items from them, but they had insisted on the rental. **MSAC (Cathy/Deb T) to approve the Treasurer's Report.**

## Unfinished Business:

- Electronic communication consent waivers – Kris said we have 12 more to go. She will work on making the waiver part of the membership application.
- FCAT equipment – The Board recommends to the membership to accept the motion made last month to approve the purchase of lure coursing equipment for FastCAT.
- Fortuna Police K9 – Nothing at this time.
- Agility trailer repair – It is at Reynolds RV now, no recent update.
- Club trailer logo – nothing at this time.
- October picnic – Debbie and Beth are helping with the organizing, Jill is taking orders and making arrangements, and will keep everyone posted.

## New Business:

- Equipment replacement requested for agility supplies – they are all small items which don't need a vote and are part of doing business.
- Barn Hunt 2022 – Susan requested and received permission to sign up Cathy Leavitt as Barn Hunt Secretary for 2022.

The Board Meeting was adjourned at 6:55 p.m.

Report of the President: Jill encouraged all members to come to the October 23 picnic at Rohner Park in Fortuna, 11-3. Club will be renting a space. Send in your menu orders to Jill soon.

Report of the Secretary: Mail: Agility materials and seminar checks from Emily, electronic consent forms, promotional and donation requests, balance of the Barn Hunt proceeds from Cathy Leavitt, a request for the return of a trophy donation, 6 Rivers invoice, a check from barn hunt secretary Cathy Leavitt plus a voucher. Sent – Condolence card to member who lost a family member, donation thank-yous, and an email followed by a hard copy of the notification to AKC Reunite that we have completed the FPD K9 transaction.

Report of the Treasurer: Bill summarized the attached Treasurer’s Report and reminded people not to send donations through PayPal. For practice donations, please use the donation jar on site or send a check. **MSAC (Cathy/Bill) to approve the Treasurer’s Report.**

Report of Committees:

- Practice: No regular practices scheduled at this time. We will try to offer a practice on October 17 at Ridgewood school, dependent on updating our facility use agreement. For conformation, rally, obedience, scentwork. Agility practice: Emily said they have been happening about 2 weekends out of 4 at Redwood Acres. The Pavilion is available for our rental on other weekends.
- Event Team: Working on venues for Scent Work.
- Scent Work Trials: Deb SM said she sent an application to College of the Redwoods for two date options to see if they would accept the proposal, but has not heard back yet. Presidents Week or Spring Break. She talked to a possible new secretary who could do small local trials.
- B-Ob Shows/Rally/FCAT 2022: **Shows** – Tina and Kris will be meeting to work on judging assignments and final contracts and look at judges for 2023 and 2024. Contact Kris with suggestions. **Rally** - Sara said we have judges, nothing else new. **FCAT** - Starting the AKC application.
- Agility Trial/Barn Hunt/FCAT 2022: **Agility:** Nothing at this time. **Barn Hunt:** Nothing new to report. **FCAT:** The Board recommends accepting and voting on the motion made last month regarding FCAT equipment. Donations toward this purchase already total \$1100. There was no further discussion so the following motion, made and seconded in August, was passed unanimously: **that the club take the recommendation of the Board and purchase lure coursing equipment for FCAT for up to \$3000.** Beth, Bayard, and Bill will work out the order.

## CH. Jo-na-da's Hershey's Kiss aka "Wrapper"

October 5, 2007 - October 4, 2021

My Italian Greyhound Wrapper missed his 14th birthday by one day. He let me know it was time.

My best boy, my old gentleman, my QB#1.

First and foremost he was my best buddy. My first puppy in 16 years when he came to live with us. Thank you Nona Molaison for trusting me with him so many years ago. My lap was his favorite spot, especially in recent times. He enjoyed good health for most of his life. He was the boss of our pack here. He loved traveling with me and was a friendly boy, a great ambassador for his breed.

Wrapper was my first "show" dog and my first AKC champion. He earned his first points at the LCKC shows and ended his career at LCKC as well. Thanks to him I was introduced to the sport of showing dogs and joined LCKC. Thanks to him I have a network of IG/dog loving friends around the world.

When he earned his first major (5 points!) at a specialty over a very large entry, I was still new to showing and really didn't have a clue about what a big deal it was. He and I learned the dog show ropes together. I was thrilled to get to show Wrapper one last time (as a veteran) back in 2019 - to Lou Guerrero, the judge who gave him that first major ten years earlier. Mr. Guerrero actually remembered Wrapper! What an honor that was.

Wrapper grew weak in recent months. He required medication for arthritis in his spine, steroids and occasional inhalers for respiratory problems, and constant dressings and treatment/cleaning for bleeding hemangiosarcomas. He sometimes needed help getting on and off the couch and would bark his silly head off if he saw Riot sitting on the couch before him. We would have to cover Riot up so Wrapper couldn't see him.

Despite still having quite a few dogs here, it is so much quieter these days. Amazing the size of the hole one little dog can leave.
